This online workshop will focus on the steps required to complete an effective and workable behavior intervention plan. Participants will be exposed to and learn about the different elements of Behaviour Intervention Plans and how to most effectively complete the Behaviour Intervention Planning process in a way that is most likely to effectively implemented in the classroom and ultimately result in student growth. In addition, participants will also learn:

- How to effectively apply data gathered during the FBA process
- How to identify appropriate strategies for specific behaviours
- How to plan for replacement behaviours
- How to most effectively identify and utilize supports that are available
- How to Identify accommodations that are most likely to support the student in displaying the replacement behavior.
